2017 NRIG Graduate Scholarships Deadline – March 31, 2017 at Midnight

Eligibility Criteria

The NRIG Graduate Scholarship will be awarded to an NRIG member currently enrolled in a PhD program, preferably nursing. Members who have previously received an NRIG Graduate Scholarship or NRIG Research Grant are not eligible.

Completed applications must include the following

1. The completed application form found attached to this document (with signature)
2. Two letters of reference that address scholarship and academic potential, ability to work with others, leadership potential, nursing expertise, and professional involvement.
3. Proof of current student status.
4. A current CV.
5. Photocopy of current RNAO/NRIG membership.

Adjudication

- Allocation of funds will be based on scholarship and academic potential; ability to work with others; leadership potential; nursing expertise, professional involvement (including involvement in RNAO and NRIG), measured by the submitted materials.
- Applicants will receive notice of the awards at the beginning of May, 2017. The award will be presented at the NRIG Annual General Meeting (date and location to be announced). Recipients are encouraged to attend the meeting.
- Names of scholarship recipients will be posted on the NRIG website.

Deadline

All completed applications, including supporting documentation, must be received electronically by midnight March 31, 2017. ALL documents to be submitted electronically by email to the address noted below. It is preferred (but not mandatory) to have the above documents scanned into a single electronic file. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the complete application is received on time. Incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed.
